



## STUDY PLUMBING AT KIT

### COURSE DURATION

- Studying Plumbing at KIT requires two and half year's fulltime
- During the first term, all students also undertake a Vocational Preparation Course.

### STUDYING PLUMBING AT KIT YOU WILL COMPLETE THREE COURSES

There are three courses, with each one building on the other as plumbing skills develop. To complete all of the plumbing courses, apply for Certificate II in Drainage first. Successful students move on to Metal Roofing and Cladding and finally to Water Training.

### WHAT WILL YOU LEARN

#### Certificate II in Drainage

- Apply Occupational Health and Safety regulations, codes and practices in the workplace
- Connect appliances from the PUB to the inside of the house
- Size and lay pipes correctly
- Install vents
- Install septic systems
- Install storm water drains

#### Certificate II in Metal Roofing & Wall Cladding

- Fix roof sheets and walls including; installation of roof sheets, wall cladding and flashing to a house

#### Water Training

- Install several types of water piping materials
- Connect the water supply to the appliance
- Install appliances and test the installation
